

## RESIDENCE INFORMATION

Students participating in the Boost Program can be accommodated in London Hall Residence.

**London Hall** features suite style accommodations. Each suite has two or three private, lockable bedrooms, a washroom, kitchen and living room. Each bedroom is furnished with a double bed, a wardrobe, a chest of drawers, a desk and chair. The residence has laundry facilities, exercise facilities and lounges. Bi-weekly cleaning is complimentary and includes cleaning of bathrooms and common spaces. Linens are not be provided. Students are responsible for the removal of their own garbage and recycling.

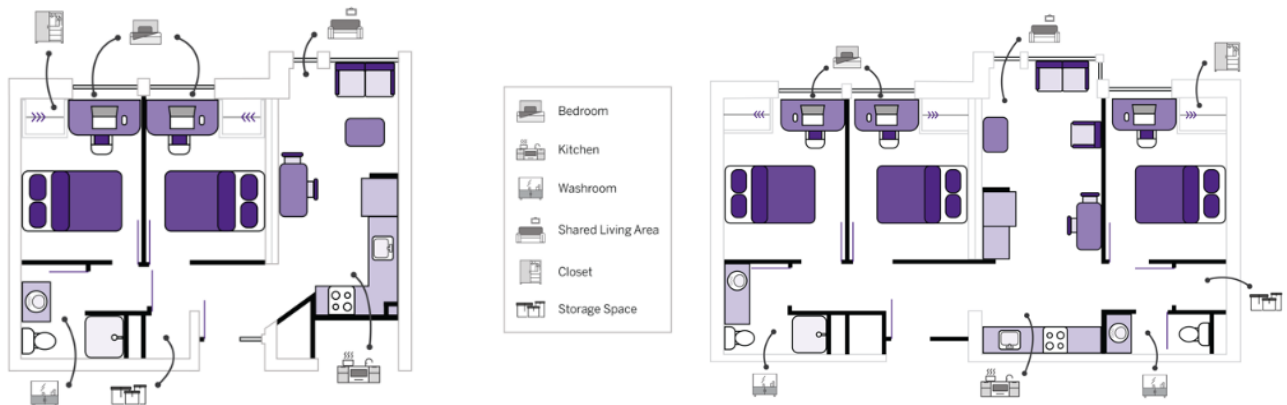
Accommodations at London Hall cost \$975/month, or \$32.50/night. Payment is taken at the Ontario Hall front desk on a monthly basis by Debit, Mastercard, Visa, or American Express. **Please do not send online payments to Housing.**

Any student living in residence for the academic year starting in September 2026 will be moving into their academic room on August 29. Students who will not be living in residence for the academic year must move out of London Hall by 12:00pm on August 29.

## HOW TO REGISTER TO STAY IN RESIDENCE DURING BOOST



You can apply to stay in residence during the Boost program through the [myHousing Portal](#).

1. Go to [myhousing.uwo.ca](http://myhousing.uwo.ca) and log in with your Western credentials.

2. Go to the **Summer Accommodations** section and scroll down to 'Select Next Step'. Select 'Request a Reservation' from the drop-down menu, then click 'Continue'. *If you cannot see this*

*option, please email [residenceoperations@uwo.ca](mailto:residenceoperations@uwo.ca) to let us know and include your student number so we can give you access.*

3. Fill out and verify the information in the required fields.

4. On the Room Type & Rate page, select 'WSA 2026 Monthly Shared Suite' option.

5. Select your arrival and departure dates. **You can only select a departure up to August 22.**

6. Once you have submitted your reservation, return to the Summer Accommodations main page and select 'Manage Upcoming Reservations'. Then select 'Manage Reservation'.

7. Select 'Submit Special Request' from the drop-down menu, then 'Continue'.

8. In the Special Request box, note that you are in the Boost program and need your reservation extended to August 29 (or other date up to August 29 as needed). If you would like to have a specific roommate, you can also note that in this section.

***Your reservation status will be 'Held' until it has been accepted. Once it has been accepted, the status will change to 'Tentative' and you will need to log back into the Portal, go to 'Manage Upcoming Reservation' again, and read and sign your Summer Contract. Once your contract has been signed, your reservation will change to a 'Reserved' status.***

## WHAT IS NOT PROVIDED WITH SUMMER ACCOMMODATIONS AT LONDON HALL THAT YOU MAY WANT TO BRING OR PURCHASE?

- Bed linens for a double sized bed (including pillows)
- Towels
- Cookware, dishes, and utensils
- Kettle (must have an automatic shut-off)
- Rice cooker (must have an automatic shut-off)
- Toaster
- Basic cleaning supplies

Once you receive your keys and pay, you will walk or take your taxi/Uber to London Hall just on the other side of Western Road.
